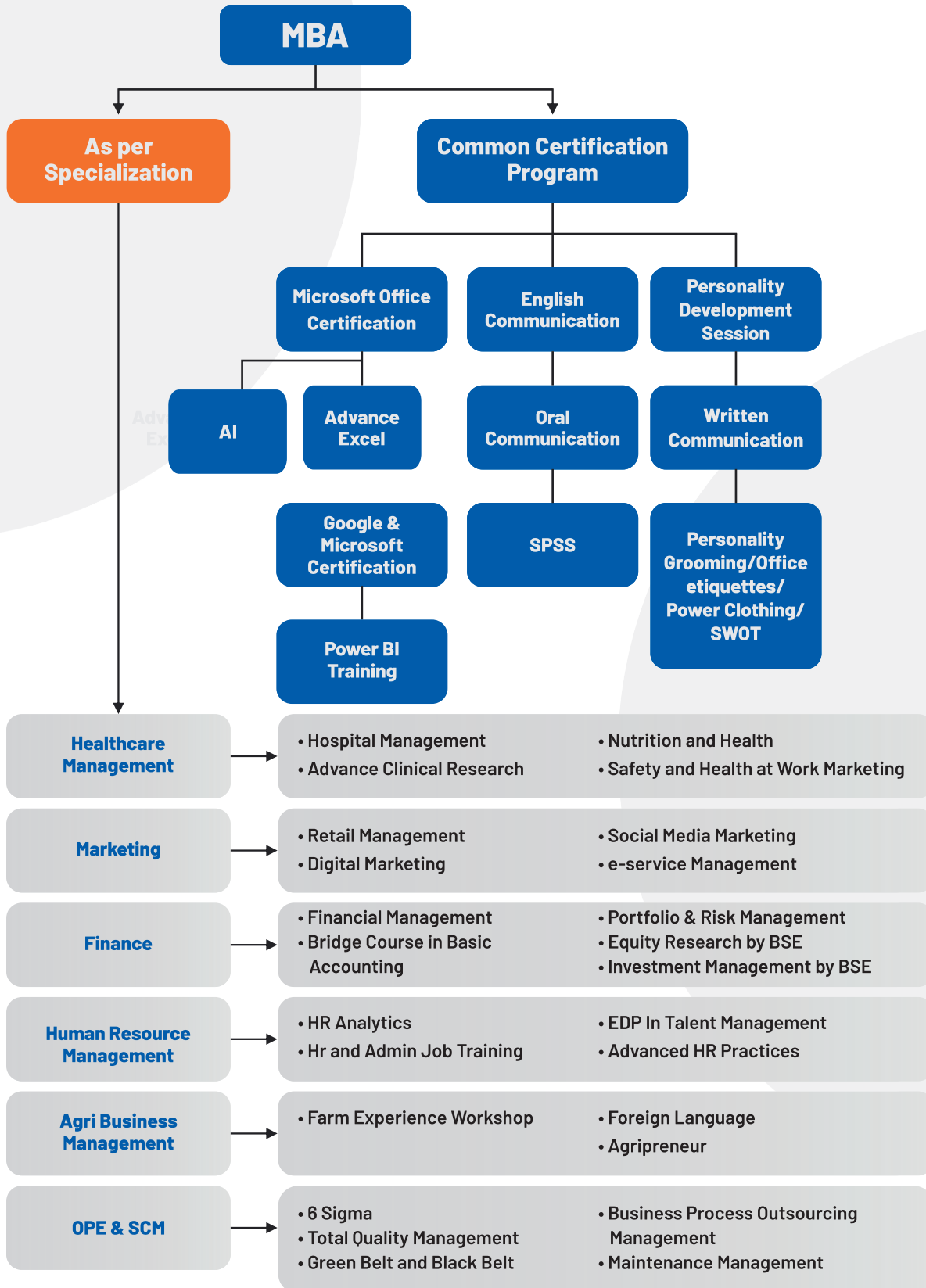
4.1 Course Types

- **4.1.1** Core courses are the compulsory courses for all the students. Core courses are of two types: Generic Core & Subject Core.
- **4.1.2** Generic Core: This is the course which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement to complete the requirement of a degree in a said discipline of study. Therefore, Generic Core courses are mandatory and fundamental in nature. These courses cannot be substituted by any other courses. Such courses are also known as Hard Core Courses.
- **4.1.3** Subject Core: A Core course may be a Subject Core if there is a choice or an option for the candidate to choose from a broad category (grouping) of subjects (specializations).
- **4.1.4** Elective Course: Elective course is a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses. It may be:
 - **4.1.5** Generic Elective: An elective course which is common across disciplines / subjects is called a generic elective. 'Generic Elective' courses develop generic proficiencies amongst the students.
 - **4.1.6** Subject Elective: A 'Discipline (specialization) centric' elective is called 'Subject Elective.' Subject Elective courses, in the Semester II, III and IV are focused on a specialization.
- **4.1.7** Research Methodology Courses: These courses are focused on various aspects of Research. They include - Business Research Methods, Desk Research (DR) and Field Project (FP) in Semester II, On The Job Training (OJT) in Semester III and Research Project (RP) in Semester IV. DR, FP, OJT and RP shall be specialization specific compulsory courses (subject core). BRM shall be a generic compulsory course.
- **4.1.8** Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs): Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) are such online courses which are developed as per the pedagogy stated in the AICTE regulation (2016) or equivalent; following the four-quadrant approach and made available on the SWAYAM platform of Government of India.

Upto 40% credits are permitted through MOOCs. Any Course of 2 Credits can be taken in the form of SWAYAM / NPTEL MOOCs provided the student secures the certificate from SWAYAM / NPTEL. MOOCs from other platforms shall not be considered valid. MOOCs cannot be opted for in case of a 3-credit course.

Eligibility for MBA Admission

MBA: Through Common Entrance Test (MH CET / CMAT / MAT / CAT / XAT / ATMA) Administered by DTE.

Minimum bachelor's degree or appeared for final year examination of a bachelor's degree & must pass the examination with requisite % marks on or before the date as published by DTE in any discipline of three years duration with minimum 50% or more marks for general category students.

Students belonging to SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC/OBC/SEBC/EWS" from Maharashtra State requisite 45% or more marks in bachelor degree with Caste Certificate, Caste Validity, Non-Creamy Layer from any statutory University approved by the appropriate Government authority & recognized by Association of Indian Universities. The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer. i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.50% to 49.99% and 44.50% to 44.99% then it shall be rounded to 50% and 45% respectively and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.01% to 49.49% and 44.01% to 44.49%, shall be rounded to 49% and 44% respectively for deciding the eligibility.

Must have completed the document verification as well as the selection procedure as prescribed by the competent authority from time to time (DTE).

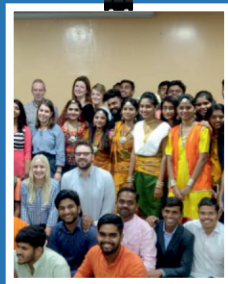

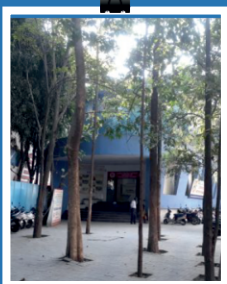

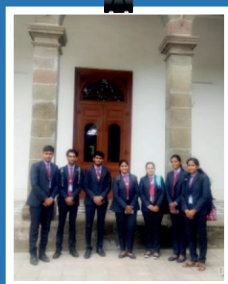
